Dear Mr. Spence:

During a recent sign inventory it was noticed that the above-referenced sign structure did not appear to be in use. Title 730:35-5-3 of the Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) stipulates that registered signs, not displaying advertising for a period of one year, shall be considered discontinued and removed at the expense of the sign owner. We have enclosed a copy of an excerpt from the OAC which references "discontinued or blank signs," along with a photo of the sign taken on the date of the inventory for that area, and a copy of the original permit application. This sign is located on the east side of US-75, approximately 2 miles south of US-62.

Therefore at this time we are placing this sign in "Discontinued Review" status as of June 10, 2019.. If the sign continues to be un-used, and we have received no photographic evidence that it has been used within a one year period (by June 10, 2020,) the sign will then be deemed illegal and required to be removed. Please be sure to forward a confirmation photograph if you place advertisement on the sign so that we can place the verification in the file and remove the sign from suspended status. However if you have no intention of continuing use of the sign, we respectfully request that the sign be removed prior to the one year period.
