Subject: Non-Conforming Status - Business Defunct (R-15057)

Jerry,

In a phone conversation with Sam Stokely yesterday we informed him that he could build R-15057, as it was indicated on the application and entered into our records (same physical aspects), but that the designation would be changed to SNQP (non-conforming) due to the business being defunct. He understands and agreed to this.

ALL ~ As we begin this new inventory and search for defunct businesses, know that we will not be cancelling/revoking any permits for unbuilt locations. The registration numbers that are discovered to have non-conforming sign sites because of a defunct business will be given a non-conforming designation (SNQP). When/if the site become conforming again (business in place) then we will change the adjudication code back to what was in place prior to the change.

Thomas and I have had discussions with most of the larger sign companies to inform them of this new process. Interestingly, the main responses that we received were "that sounds right, and that sounds fair". Those company representatives are as follows: Lamar OKC & Central, Lindmark, Whistler, Stokely, Byers, M2 Outdoor, Vital. We are waiting for a call back from Fairway, Arnold & Headrick. Let me us know if you think of other sign companies that would benefit from a heads up.

Also of interest ~ Trent Lindmark informed us that he will be buying FMG (previously known as Fairway) the whole company, not just the assets, he should close by the end of this month. As the owner, he will be maintaining the name FMG, keeping the same address for correspondence and also keep the current employees in place. The best news for us (Kellie specifically) means that NO TRANSFERS will have to take place. Trent told us that his intentions are to offer financial expenses quickly to their field crews so that they can make sign repairs rapidly before they become issues with the various states that FMG has signs in. He is aware of the signs that are currently on our tracking log and will work quickly to get those resolved.
