SNQP:

A Class "B" Permit for a legal non-conforming or "grandfathered" sign. If the sign is ever removed, destroyed or damaged beyond fifty percent, it cannot be re-built. Sign must remain substantially the same as it existed on date of original inventory and maintained in accordance with state law. Customary maintenance guidelines can be found in OAC 730:35-5-3.

ISSUANCE STATEMENT

Pursuant to the Highway Advertising Control Act O.S. 1991§ 1271, et. seq., as amended, and the regulations promulgated by the Oklahoma Transportation Commission, this permit is issued as effective for the continued existence of the specific outdoor advertising, display or device as identified above, as its location as of the field inspection date. The permit relates to the combined site and structure and shall be deemed transferred with change of ownership of the sign structure at its present location. The issuance of this permit shall not be construed to supersede or override any ordinance, act or rule of a city, town, county, zoning authority or other duly constituted regulatory body, which may forbid or otherwise restrict the sign, signal structure or message displayed, or any other incident of control of the sign or its use. Unless sooner revoked this permit shall continue in force through the expiration date specified above.
