Montie,

The appraisal does mention that the sign was completed in 2010, I was just looking for something a little more precise. There are several things I'm trying to track down in this situation and would like to request that you provide any info you may have.

This acquisition was an advanced acquisition, the first time we looked at the property, early 2010 I think, there was no sign. When we showed up to appraise the sign in December 2010 there was a sign.

I'm trying to determine where the breakdown happened in regard to the Department issuing a permit for a location we were fixing to acquire.

I'm trying to determine a price that we want to sell the sign for today or in the near future at an auction. The actual cost of the sign was \$237,412.00 when it was installed, it has been estimated to cost \$22,000.00 to move the sign. Doing the simple math I told the previous owner that the asking price was 237,412 - 22,000 for a total of 215,412, knowing that we could not expect to get that much. Now the previous owner is saying that an equivalent sign installed new today would cost about \$45,000.00 less than the cost new last year. So, if you take that cost and subtract the real cost to relocate the existing sign, \$35,000, plus subtract 15% depreciation the signs value is no more than \$100,000.00 or so.

Also, I what is the typical life of a sign of this type for the purposes of calculating depreciation

Any help you can provide would be most appreciated.


