Mr. Posey,

As I stated during our phone conversation, the application for sign registration can be approved with the exception of 2 possible residences that are in the area of the sign site. (See Google Map attached) You informed me that the supposed residence on the east side of US-75 was actually not a residence and that the "Seth Eller" location in a vacant trailer. We are requesting that you advise our office regarding the determination of these two sites. If they are determined to be residences then we will need a residential consent signed from the property owners stating that they are okay with your sign being within 300' of their property. If not, then please notify our office of the determination.
