Dear Mr. Anderson:

This is to notify you that during a recent inspection of the area the above-referenced advertising structures were discovered to still be in place and are in illegal status pursuant to the Federal Highway Beautification Act and the Oklahoma Outdoor Advertising Control Act. (Photos are enclosed for your review.) The department was lenient during Covid and suspended our due dates for removal of illegal sign structures.

At this time, we respectfully request that the structures be brought into compliance by obtaining a Class "A" permit, if regulations can be met, or removing them within ninety (90) days of receipt of this notice. Please be advised that failure to take appropriate action shall result in prompt legal action being taken for which you shall be assessed both the legal fees and the costs of removal if the State is required to remove the advertisement.

Re: Illegal Advertising signs Ottawa & Cherokee Regulated Routes

Dear Mr. Anderson:

As you are aware, this office regulates outdoor advertising located adjacent to certain routes of highway, for the State of Oklahoma. We work in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration and most of our rules and regulations are based on the Highway Beautification Act.

You have been informed multiple times that a permit is required for advertising devices adjacent to regulated routes, and every time that we ask you to remove a sign you merely relocate it to another location, circumventing the law. We have enclosed a list of offending advertisements.

On advisement from our Legal counsel, we are notifying you that all of the illegal advertising for NEO Bail Bonds on regulated routes must be removed within 45 days. If not, an injunction will be filed against you that will impact any illegal advertisement in any county in the state of Oklahoma. The injunction will allow the State to remove all advertisement devices (signs, trailers, vehicles, benches, etc.) with NEO Bail Bonds advertisement on them.

This is your FINAL WARNING, no more 90-day notifications.
