Re: Abandoned Sign Notice

Sign Registration No. 15499

SH-66, Rogers County

Dear Mr. Parsons:

During a recent field inspection, it was noticed that the above-referenced sign structure has been damaged. A photograph confirming this determination has been enclosed. This sign is located on the east side of SH-66, approximately 1.76 miles north of SH-266. According to the Oklahoma Administrative Code 730:35-5-3 an abandoned sign is defined as follows:

A registered sign in need of substantial repair, or which is overgrown by trees or other vegetation not on the highway right-of-way or is otherwise no longer being utilized as an outdoor advertising device, for a period of one (1) year, shall be considered "abandoned" and any nonconforming or grandfather status granted by the Highway Advertising Control Act shall be terminated. Leasing information shall not be considered advertising content for the purpose of this definition.

Therefore, at this time according to CFR § 750.707 (6) (i & ii) and the Oklahoma Administrative Code we are placing this sign in "Abandoned Review" status as of June 26, 2023. If the sign remains abandoned and we have received no photographic evidence that this sign has been refurbished and is displaying advertisement within a one year period, the sign will be deemed illegal and required to be removed. If you agree with this determination and have no intention of continuing use of the sign, we respectfully request that the sign be removed prior to the one year period.
