NEW NHS HIGHWAY NOTIFICATION

Dear Mr. Wood:

Our office was recently informed that SH-66 in Rogers County where the above-referenced sign is located, was officially accepted by the Federal Highway Administration as part of the National Highway System (NHS.) As you may or may not be aware, all outdoor advertising signs adjacent or advertising to routes of highways that are part of the NHS, are required to be registered with the Department of Transportation. June 13th an inventory of signs was taken along the subject route. Signs that were in existence were photographed and documented. A current photo of the sign structure has been enclosed for your review.

Currently, we are notifying the owners of these signs to register them with the Department of Transportation. We have enclosed the proper application forms necessary to register these signs. If the sign can meet current Class "A" requirements, then a Class "A" Permit will be issued. However, if it cannot, then a Grandfathered or Legal Non-conforming status can be assigned if the sign type or structure has not been altered since the inventory.

If you are the owner of this sign, please complete one of the enclosed application forms, and submit it along with required items to this office within ninety (90) days of receiving this letter. If you are not the owner of this sign, then please contact our office as soon as possible.
